

City Offers Free Towing of Inoperable Vehicles



Remember that old car you got from your uncle five or six years ago that is now just sitting in the back yard rusting? Well, here is a way to get rid of it once and for all. The City of Tallahassee's towing vendor has agreed to remove inoperable vehicles **at no cost to you** from private property through the end of the year, for anyone living within the city limits. This offer is limited to personal vehicles such as passenger autos and light trucks such as pickups.

The City's Code Enforcement Division addresses a wide range of property issues that affect our community's environment, health, safety and property values, including derelict or inoperable vehicles. This includes vehicles that do not display a current license tag, are not equipped with all parts required to legally and safely operate on public streets and cannot be driven under their own power. Derelict/inoperable vehicles cannot be stored except in a fully enclosed, legally constructed building.
