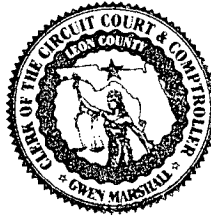

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT WE Sandco, LLC
