

RESOLUTION NO. 89-R-0024

ADOPTED 8/30/89  
A RESOLUTION IDENTIFYING CAPITAL PROJECTS  
TO BE FUNDED FROM THE CITY OF TALLAHASSEE SHARE  
OF THE ONE-CENT SALES TAX

WHEREAS, the City of Tallahassee and Leon County have agreed to place a sales tax levy on the ballot on September 19, 1989, to address significant community improvements in the area of law enforcement and transportation, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission wishes to inform voters of its plans for the expenditure of the City's share of such funds,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City of Tallahassee is committed to spend funds for the following list of projects:

A. Advance funding of state road projects

1. Capital Circle multilaning right-of-way (Centerville to Mahan)
2. Capital Circle multilaning construction (Centerville to Mahan)
3. Interstate-10 East Ramp and Raymond Diehl Road project
4. South Adams (4 Points to Bronough-Duval overpass)
- \*5. North Monroe (Tharpe to I-10)
6. Gaines-Bloxham (Lake Bradford to Franklin)
7. Capital Circle multilaning (Mahan to Apalachee)
- \*8. Capital Circle multilaning (Blountstown to West Tennessee)
9. Pensacola Street (Capital Circle to Appleyard Drive)
10. Blountstown Hwy (Capital Circle to Aeon Church Road)

B. Advance funding of county projects

1. Orange Avenue (Monroe to Blair Stone)
2. Thomasville Road right-of-way (I-10 to Woodbine Drive)

C. City law enforcement project

1. Police building expansion

F. Advance funding for Florida Department of Transportation projects is subject to successful negotiation of an agreement with the State of Florida which insures repayment by the State.

G. Advance funding for Leon County projects is subject to successful negotiation of an agreement with Leon County which insures repayment by the County.

H. The list of projects may be amended by the City Commission to reflect changes in the 2010 Transportation Plan as determined by the Metropolitan Planning Organization, changes in the City of Tallahassee or Leon County Comprehensive Plans, or changing transportation needs due to unforeseen circumstances such as, but not limited to, FDOT rescheduling of its five-


