

RESOLUTION NO. 98-R-0046

**A RESOLUTION IDENTIFYING MODIFICATIONS TO THE LIST OF
CAPITAL PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED FROM THE CITY OF
TALLAHASSEE'S SHARE OF THE LOCAL OPTION ONE-CENT SALES TAX**

WHEREAS, Leon County voters approved a Local Option One-Cent Sales Tax by referendum on September 19, 1989, which is effective from December 1, 1989, until November 30, 2004, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 89-R-0024 on August 30, 1989, identifying the Capital Projects the City of Tallahassee is committed to constructing with its share of these additional Sales Tax Revenues, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 89-R-0024 provided the list of Capital Projects may be amended by the City Commission, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted a policy on March 10, 1993, which provides for annual review of the Sales Tax Capital Projects, holding a public hearing if revisions are needed, and affecting revisions to the Capital Projects List by resolution adoption, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted Resolutions No. 94-R-0030 (AA) on September 14, 1994, No. 95-R-0039 on September 27, 1995, and No. 97-R-0034 on September 24, 1997, which amended the Capital Projects List, and Resolution No. 95-R-0060 (AA) on December 6, 1995, which amended the conditions for expenditure of the City of Tallahassee's share of the Local Option One-Cent Sales Tax for FDOT projects,


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Commission, pursuant to its commitments and policy, amends the City of Tallahassee's Sales Tax Capital Projects List, contained in its Resolution Nos. 89-R-0024, 94-R-0030 (AA), 95-R-0039, and 97-R-0034, by adding the following projects to the indicated section:

- D. City Projects
 - 21. Welaunee Boulevard (Capital Circle to Fleischmann)
- F. Other Projects
 - 2. Stadium Drive/Call Street/Bryan Street Intersection Improvement (Advance Funding to FSU)


