In order to receive your permit in a timely manner, make sure that the following items have been addressed:

1. All hazardous materials must be removed and properly disposed of prior to demolition. Check for the following:

- _____ fluorescent lights and ballasts
- _____ high intensity discharge bulbs
- _____ mercury-containing switches such as thermostats
- _____ neon signs
- _____ chemicals such as paint, solvents, pesticides, etc.
- _____ batteries such as lead-acid and nickel-cadmium
- _____ lead roof vents/flashing

2. Any unused wells must be properly abandoned by a Florida licensed Water Well Contractor. (Per Northwest Florida Water Management District rule 40A-3 and Leon County code 10-1957; call the NFWFMD at (850) 539-5999 for information.)

- _____ unused wells

3. Petroleum storage tanks (underground and above ground) must have any remaining fuel pumped out.

- _____ storage tanks

****Receipts for proper disposal of hazardous materials must be presented to the Aquifer Protection Coordinator. Contact the Leon County Hazardous Waste Center at (850) 922-0400 for information on proper disposal.
