FACTS TO SUPPORT ABOVE CHARGE(S): On this date I responded to the Hotel Duval at 415 N. Monroe St. in reference to a guest wanting to file a report about his Wallet and Phone that were stolen. Upon my arrival I made contact with the Manager, Sean Coomer, at the front desk. Mr. Coomer stated that they have a celebrity guest, Nicholas Brendon, that has taken pills and alcohol while he has been at the hotel today. He was walking around the hotel with blood on him and his clothes torn and wet from a toilet overflow he created in room 712.

While talking to Mr. Coomer, Mr. Brendon arrived in the lobby. He was wearing a tee shirt and pajama pants that had a tear across the front of them in the crotch area. As he approached me, he stumbled as he walked and appeared to be in a state of confusion. I asked him what was going on. He stated "not much, just hanging out. I'm in town to sign autographs." I said, "Ok, did you call about your phone and wallet being stolen" He stated "yes, but I don't want to do anything about it." We walked back to Mr. Brendon's room (425). When we got there we entered the room together. I observed a wallet on the desk in the room. I asked him if that was his wallet. He looked around, still in a confused state, and said, "Oh yes that's my wallet." I asked him if he knew where his phone was. He went through the room but could not locate the phone. I asked him if it was possible that he lost it and that it wasn't stolen. He said "that probably could be the case."

While in Mr. Brendon's presence I observed him with toothpaste all over his face and shirt, his pants were torn, he had defecated on himself and the pajama pants were wet below the knees. I left him in room 425 while I walked with an employee to another room that he requested because he wanted an upgrade. That room was room 712. I went there with the staff worker to see if he possibly left the phone in that room and didn't realize it due to his condition. When we arrived at the room, the door was partially open and there was water soaking the carpet in the hallway. I pushed the door open to find that the furniture in the room had been damaged and turned upside down. There was a porcelain decorative piece that appeared to be thrown against the wall that was shattered on the floor. The door to the dresser area was ripped off, the phone was pulled out of the wall socket and the bed was flipped off of its rails. The floor in the bathroom area was covered in water and it was flowing over onto the carpet. At this time it is unknown the exact dollar amount of the damages and cleanup. It is estimated to be more than \$200 but less than \$1000.

At this point I made contact with the Manager, Mr. Coomer, and explained what we discovered in room 712. Mr. Coomer proceeded to explain the following events of this evening. He stated that at 3:05pm Mr. Brendon arrived and checked into the hotel. He stated at 8:07pm Mr. Coomer requested an upgrade because of his status as a TV star. Mr. Coomer stated that he did not have any upgrades for the night but that he could move him to a higher floor. Mr. Brendon stated that he would like that and Mr. Coomer registered him into a second room. Mr. Coomer asked Mr. Brendon if he would like some help moving his luggage but Mr. Brendon declined and stated that he could do it himself. At 8:45, Mr. Coomer received a report from guests that Mr.

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Brendon was sleeping in front of his door at room 425. Staff arrived to find him there where they woke him up and escorted him back to room 712. At that time the room appeared intact. The damage occurred between 8:45 and 9:52pm when Mr. Brendon occupied the room. At 9:52pm Mr. Coomer contacted the Police Department at the request of Mr. Brendon to help him locate his stolen wallet and iphone. Mr. Coomer stated that during the time I was in room 712 taking photos of the damage he receive a call from the guests in room 219 stating that Mr. Brendon knocked on their door and then proceeded to walk in. Staff arrived and removed Mr. Brendon from the room, bringing him back to room 425.

Sgt. Mahoney arrived on scene at this point as we were discussing making the arrest of Mr. Brendon for Criminal Mischief of a lodging establishment. Mr. Coomer received a call from his staff that Mr. Brendon was back up at the bar on Level 8. It was at this location where I made contact with Mr. Brendon and placed him under arrest. He was cooperative and asked what he was being charged with. He was explained that he did damage to a room and that the management was pressing charges. Mr. Brendon F.S. 119

I explained to Mr. Brendon that the same cigarettes he had in room 425 were also found in room 712.

While in room 425 with Mr. Brendon after he had been placed under arrest, I noticed a prescription pill bottle sitting on the dresser. It was filled today with 10 pills. There was only one pill left in the bottle. I became concerned about Mr. Brendon's well being and asked him if he took 9 of the pills he got today. F.S. 119

Mr. Coomer stated that he wanted to press charges and provided a sworn written statement for the damage to room 712 and issued a TPW to Mr. Brendon for the hotel property. F.S. 119. Mr. Coomer stated that he would have his staff pack Mr. Brendon's luggage and store it until he could send someone to pick it up. Mr. Brendon stated that he wanted that service from the hotel and that he appreciated it. Digital photos were taken of the damaged property in room 712.

Mr. Brendon was transported to TMHER where he was checked for the quantity of sleeping pills he took and given a tetanus shot for the cut he had on his right thumb. He was medically cleared and transported to LCJ.
