On-going Studio Art Classes

These on-going classes are offered on a weekly basis in the Art Studios at the Tallahassee Senior Center. The instructors work with individuals with varied skill levels while students assist and critique one another in an exciting, collaborative environment. To participate, come and visit, chat with the instructor, find out what art supplies you need to bring for class and jump in.

No preregistration required for these on-going studio classes; just pay the days you come. Fee per class: \$10 (age 50 and older), \$12 (age 18 - 49). Art cards – pay for 7 classes and get one free! Check with instructors about anticipated no-class days.

Hands-On Art History with Mark Fletcher

Mondays, 12:30 – 3 p.m., TSC Clay Studio. Discover hands-on techniques of the masters, old and new, through research of how and why they developed their style in the context of their times. Create your own art applying and combining the methods of various artists like Van Gogh, Monet, Durer and others. Beginners welcome.

On-Going Studio Labs (No Instructor)

Portrait Studio Lab, Monday, 9 a.m. – noon, \$5
Draw or paint from live model, bring your own art supplies, no instructor.

Ceramics, Tuesday & Wednesday, 9 a.m. – noon,
\$2 lab fee, plus cost of materials and firing fee. Use mold-made bisque items to paint or glaze. Lead by helpful volunteers. *Perfect for beginners.* Experienced hand building clay people can use as a lab.

Pastel Landscapes, Wed., 9 – noon. Pastels can provide vibrancy and subtleties unlike other mediums. Art Studio. \$4.

Art Workshops – Oct – Dec. 2019

Art workshops require pre-registration and pre-payment. Most workshops meet once-a-week at the Tallahassee Senior Center unless otherwise indicated. Clay Creations – Mark Fletcher. Mondays, Oct. 21 - Dec. 16, 9 a.m. – noon, TSC Clay Studio, All skill levels. Create in clay with focus on making sculptural additions like animals to hand built functional vessels. Some glazes and firing included in class fee. \$80 (age 50+), \$96 (others). Register by Oct. 14.

Engage With your Page, Mary Liz Tippin-Moody Tuesdays, Nov. 5 – Dec. 17, 1 – 3:30 p.m., TSC Clay Studio. Create images on paper with a variety of media and processes – a creative playtime for beginners and continuing students. Use your sketchbook to develop ideas and images with drawing, painting, collage and simple printmaking techniques. Drawing and painting guidance available. Students bring their own art supplies.
