- For water source heat pumps or heat pump water heaters, have your contractor provide brand, model number and manufacturer's efficiency specifications on his invoice, receipt or proposal.

Conditions and Requirements

- For rebates to be paid, this application must be completed entirely and submitted with required documentation (see above).
- Rebates are paid to the utility customer or property owner for equipment retrofits in existing homes. Not applicable to equipment installed during new construction prior to receiving a Certificate of Occupancy.
- The qualifying equipment must be installed in a permanent residence receiving City of Tallahassee electric service.
- An installation permit and a Completed (passed) final inspection are required.
- Rebates are available for equipment final-inspected after February 20, 2008.
- Rebate applications must be received within three months of the installation's Final Inspection date.
- Air conditioning and heat pump rebates are for permitted, inspected installations of complete, ARI-matched systems with an ARI certificate. Rebates are not paid for unmatched systems having no ARI certificate.
- By participating in this program, the applicant agrees that the City of Tallahassee obtains and/or retains ownership of all rights to existing and future emission credits, renewable energy rights to existing and future emissions credits, renewable energy green tags, tradable renewable certificates and/or any and all other environmental benefits associated with installation of the eligible equipment.
