

**MAJOR FUNCTION**

This is skilled work which requires overhead and underground electrical utility work involved in the construction, maintenance, operation, and extension of power, lighting, and signal systems. Work is subject to check and review by a supervisor; employees perform assignments independently in accordance with safe work practices.

**ESSENTIAL AND OTHER IMPORTANT JOB DUTIES****Essential Duties**

Performs maintenance and construction on overhead and underground electric facilities including the ability to use electric hot line equipment and tools. Connects transformer banks, fuses transformers and installs wires and parts, identifies location of important circuits and cut out fuses. Handles variety of emergency problems during and after storms, sets meters, makes load checks and provides other customer services. Operates bucket and line trucks and associated equipment. Performs related work as required.

**Other Important Duties**

May be assigned to be lead lineworkers as required. Flags traffic as needed. Performs related work as required.

**DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS****Knowledge, Abilities and Skills**

Thorough knowledge of the safe work practices, methods, vehicles, equipment and tools used in the erection, maintenance, operation, and repair of electric lines. Knowledge of electrical theory. Thorough knowledge of occupational hazards connected with work. Ability to climb poles and towers and to perform all phases of lineworkers' work in a safe manner. Skills in the proper use of lineworkers' tools. Ability to perform manual work during adverse weather conditions.

**Minimum Training and Experience**

Possession of a high school diploma or an equivalent recognized certificate and satisfactory completion of an apprenticeship program as an apprentice lineworker in the erection, maintenance and repair of overhead and/or underground electrical line systems.

**Necessary Special Requirement**

Must possess the appropriate State Commercial Driver's License (CDL) and endorsement(s) at the time of appointment.
