This year's event will be held on Saturday, December 4th from 3:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m.

Thousands from our community came out and supported the Celebration of Lights in previous years and we expect our participation to grow this year. As the Festival has grown in both size and quality, the need for a large number of volunteers is essential.

Volunteers are needed to assist us in the following areas:

- A. **PARADE STAGING MARSHAL** - 4:30 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.
This involves placing parade entries in their correct position in the line-up; checking parade numbers; help maintain proper spacing between entries; removal of permits, etc.
- B. **PARADE ROUTE MARSHAL** - 6:30 p.m. until 9:00 p.m.
This involves crowd control, "Speed up/Slow down" signals, etc.
- D. **COSTUME CHARACTER** - 2:30 p.m. until 10:00 p.m.
These characters are to be animated in action and are in a non-speaking role while in costume. The characters will be on stage during the Lighting Ceremony with the mayor and special Winter Festival guests; involved in the Parade and Roving throughout the festival area during the evening.
NOTE: Costume Characters must be at least 5'7" tall. Anyone with vision problems, heat conditions, claustrophobia, allergies to wools, has problem standing for long periods of time, or tires quickly, should refrain from signing up for this position.
- E. **ELVES (guides for Costume Characters)** - 2:30 p.m. until 10:00 p.m.
You are the eyes - the heads on the costumes have limited vision. Additionally, you are the voice – Costume Characters are in non-speaking roles while in costume. You will alert the Costume Character of any potential hazards - i.e. flashbulbs, curbs, barricades and objects in the walkway, etc.

As you can see, there is something for everyone! We are hoping that you would be willing to dedicate a few hours of your valuable time as a volunteer for this exciting, wonderful holiday extravaganza. We will provide you with training and the necessary equipment for each assignment. Each volunteer must fill out the attached Volunteer Information Sheet to be eligible for participation. Once you have completed the Volunteer Information Form Sheet please submit to the Winter Festival Office at the address provided. You will receive via the mail or e-mail a confirmation of your request and directions of where to report and what to expect. We look forward to working with you.

Please indicate the position(s) in which you would like to participate as a Winter Festival volunteer. **Please indicate your first and second choices.** You must be 16 years or older to be a volunteer, and if you are under 18, you must have parental or guardian consent.
